Maryhill Estate in Glumslöv, Skåne opened on November 18, 2024, and offers two distinct buildings with restaurants, pools, and social spaces designed to make gathering effortlessly pampered. Previously known as "Örenäs Slott," the name has been changed back to Maryhill, a name with historical roots. The largest part, with 147 rooms, a restaurant, pool club, and several meeting spaces in true resort spirit, is called The Sugar Club. The smaller, older building (formerly the castle), with 16 rooms and the most historical significance, is named Hill House. This is a place for those seeking a break from the city's hustle while still enjoying the feeling of life and vibrance.

An experience at Maryhill is a daydream played out in reality. The atmosphere is classic, elegant, and visually appealing, with a touch of timeless glamour. The décor is femininely stylish, with floral pastel patterns as a recurring theme. Glasses gently clink with champagne - but with a twist. This reflects our carefully considered blend of modern luxury and historical simplicity.

Extraordinary, culinary sensations are at the heart of Maryhill, and each of the different parts has its own gastronomic concept, always served with the same quality of service in a spot-on way, reminiscent of times gone by. The Sugar Club offers a generous Mediterranean dining experience, full of authentic flavors and influences from Greece and Italy. The charismatic service makes guests feel at home, and the colorful dishes shared among friends make the experience relaxed and socially memorable. In contrast, Hill House offers a flirty experience inspired by the joyful 1920s, with memorable French-American dishes that spark conversation and foster community."Ålabodarna's Harbor Restaurant" is located right by the sea, offering classic seafood dishes.

For a resort with a focus on gastronomy, it's fitted that Robert "Bobbo" Nilsson is the CEO of Maryhill Estate. His experience is long, broad, and international, spanning Sri Lanka, Dubai, and China. His history includes the Nobel Banquet and awards such as Chef of the Year 1998 and Scandinavian Chef of the Year 2000. Next, we have the Food & Beverage Manager Martin Hansen, who brings a wealth of experience from Saison and Petri Pumpa. With 30 years of expertise in Nordic fine dining, his impressive resume includes a gold medal at the Culinary World Cup and an Olympic gold medal in the Culinary Olympics. In addition to daydreams with recurring shaken martinis, Maryhill offers a variety of activities, including tennis, petanque courts, archery, croquet, and golf—just a stone's throw away. For relaxation, there's the Sugar Club and 120 sunbeds with three refreshing pools to wander between, not to forget the one in front of Hill House, and also some fresh air in the kitchen garden, located right next to it. Wherever your mind leads you, it will be an experience without boundaries. The picturesque setting on a hill surrounded by greenery with an astonishing view of the ocean is the perfect place to forge bonds and begin everlasting love -for real. With its rich history, Maryhill has proudly hosted weddings and wedding parties that have gone down in history.
